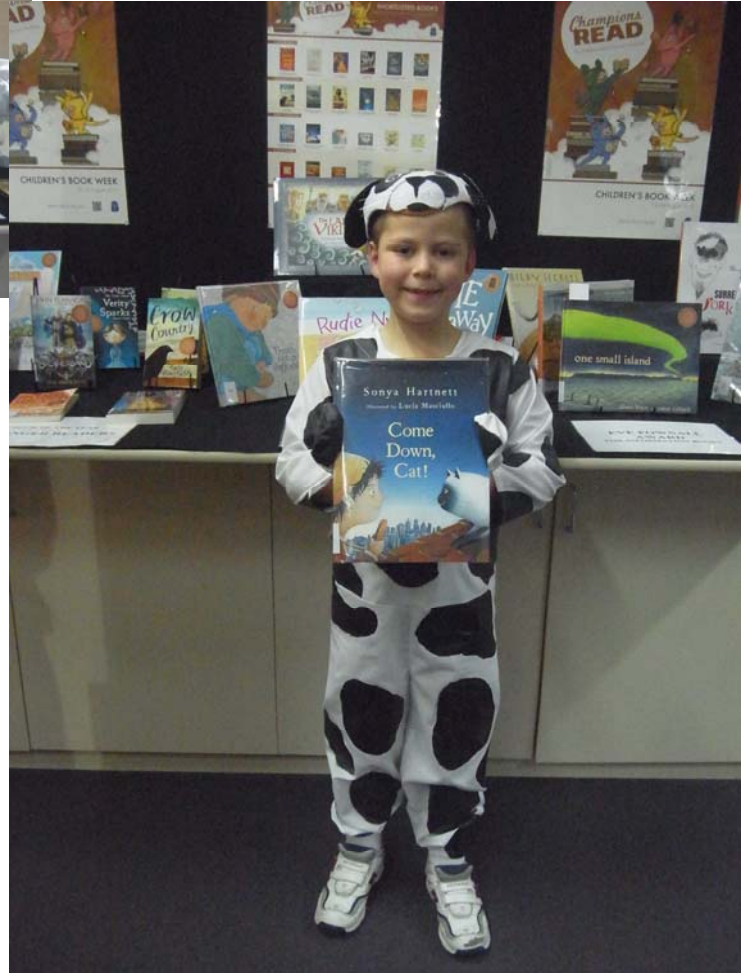
Trial details will be between 8.45am to 10.45am on Thursday 30 August at Lynwood SHS gym and oval.
